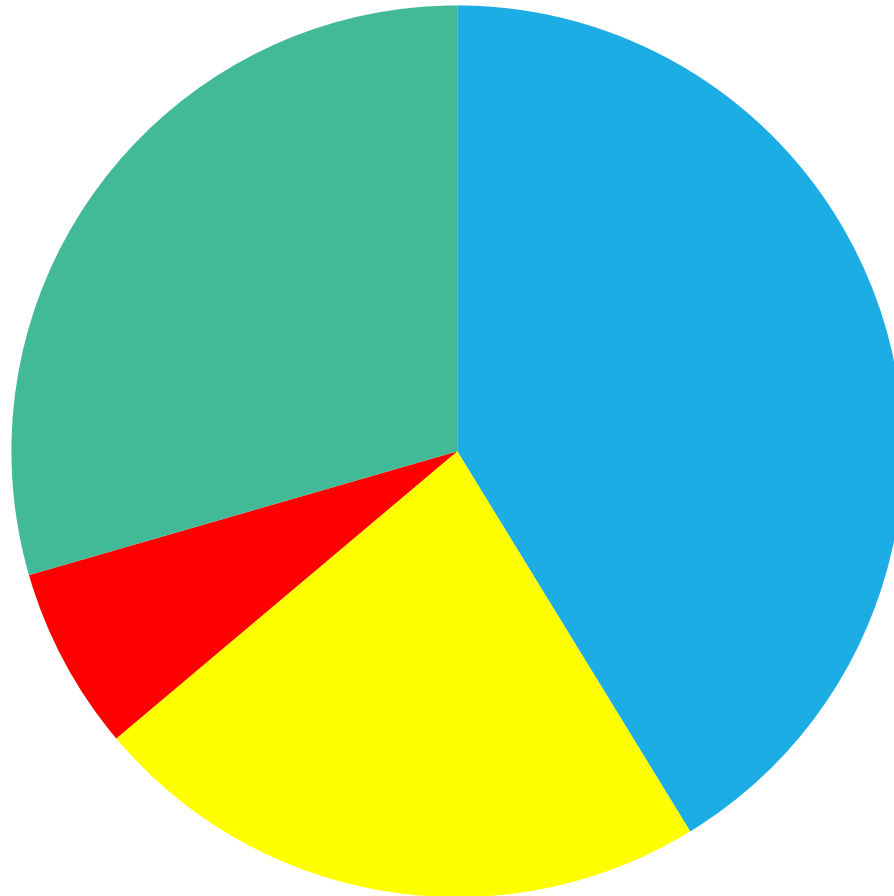

ICT Services

- ❑ distance learning courses – integrating synchronic and a-synchronic methods and technologies.
- ❑ “hybrid” courses, combining distance learning and classroom learning.
- ❑ WiFi throughout the campus.
- ❑ All classrooms equipped with computers and screening devices.
- ❑ public computers in main library + plug points for laptops.
- ❑ projects that integrate mobile learning.
- ❑ well developed support system for staff and students.
- ❑ Moodle - LMS (Learning Management System) is used in all courses.
- ❑ Blackboard Collaborate software is used for synchronic distance learning meetings.
